## **NCHEPM EXECUTIVE BOARD ELECTION RESULTS**

Because the position of chair is currently vacant, Migdalia Gonzalez, vice chair, will lead the Council until special elections can be held in the new year to fill the two vacant positions. Additionally, five new subcommittee leads will be appointed in January 2024 by the newly elected Board members. Board members serve for a two-year term.

For more than 25 years, the NCHEPM has worked to share vital information and resources to assist Hispanic Employment Program Managers and other DEIA practitioners in building coalitions and networks to enhance the recruitment, development and retention of Hispanics in the federal workforce. The NCHEPM is implementing programs and initiatives to inform the work of these practitioners and thereby improve the success and sustainability of the work they undertake.
