NCHEPM EXECUTIVE BOARD NOMINATION PERIOD NOW OPEN

WASHINGTON – The National Council of Hispanic Employment Program Managers (NCHEPM), the nation’s premiere authority on efforts to improve and accelerate Hispanic participation and representation in the Federal government, announced today the start of the 2024 nomination period for its Executive Board positions.

Beginning Wednesday, Oct. 25, NCHEPM members may nominate themselves or other individuals to fill the five Executive Board positions of Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Public Relations & Communication Coordinator, Membership Coordinator, and Treasurer. Board members serve for a two-year term. Voting will commence Nov. 13-Dec. 1, and results will be shared during the [NCHEPM End-of-Year Wrap-Up & Virtual Holiday Party](#) to be held Wednesday, Dec. 13, from 3-4:40 p.m. ET.

Additionally, five new subcommittees leads will be appointed in January 2024 by the newly elected Board members.

“Prior ‘DEIA experience’ for any of the positions is not required—just a willingness to serve, learn and grow as individuals and professionals. This is a wonderful opportunity to dive into DEIA work and support historically underserved communities,” stated current Chair Glorimar Maldonado. “We’re looking for individuals who are ready, willing and able to flex their leadership muscles and take on the work of the Council.”

For more than 25 years, the NCHEPM has worked to share vital information and resources to assist Hispanic Employment Program Managers and other DEIA practitioners in building coalitions and networks to enhance the recruitment, development and retention of Hispanics in the federal workforce. The NCHEPM is implementing programs and initiatives to inform the work of these practitioners and thereby improve the success and sustainability of the work they undertake.
