## NCHEPM VICE CHAIR JAVIER INCLÁN ELECTED TO SENIOR EXECUTIVES ASSOCIATION BOARD

WASHINGTON – The National Council of Hispanic Employment Program Managers (NCHEPM), the nation's premiere authority on efforts to improve and accelerate Hispanic participation and representation in the Federal government, announced today the election of NCHEPM Vice Chair Javier Inclán to the board of the Senior Executives Association (SEA).
